## *My Story:*

We've been in a series called Crosswords talking about the final words that Jesus spoke while on the cross and how people's last words represent their honest thoughts and feelings. Have you experienced a conversation with a loved one that is no longer with us? If so how did their final words impact you?

- Jesus had 7 things to say while on the cross and we have discussed 5 of them so far. Which of the 5 things that Jesus said so far has impacted you the most and why?
  - He issued a Divine **Pardon**. Read Luke 23:34.
  - He gave the thief on the Cross **Assurance** of his salvation that very day. Read Luke 23:43.
  - How did he show **Compassion** to his momma and others? Read John 19:26-27.
  - Why do you think Jesus showed **Frustration** that day? Read Matt 27:45.
  - According to Pastor Rick what were the 3 reasons Jesus **Suffered**? ( Listen to Sunday Message) Read John 19:28-29.

## *Diving Deeper:*

- Read Hebrews 4:15 How does it help to know that we have a High Priest who can relate to us?
  
- What does the writer of Hebrews 4 say we can expect if we go to God? Read Hebrews 4: 16 (NLT).
  
- Why is this important?
  
- Hundreds and thousands of years before Jesus came on the Scene the Scriptures describes for us who Jesus is and what he will do. Take a moment and go through some of them.
  - The place of His birth - Micah 5:2.
  
  - The time of His birth - Daniel 9:25.
  
  - The manner of His birth - Isaiah 7:14.
  
  - The precise manner of death - Psalm 22:15-18 and Psalm 69:21.

- These are just 4 of many. How does the scriptural revelation about Jesus help us to see who Jesus is?
- How is it like giving someone an address that leads us directly to their house? Discuss.
- How does Christ sufferings reveal the sufficiency of Jesus to keep us out of Hell? Read Hebrews 5:8-9. Discuss.
- How might being thirsty for the wrong things keep us thirsty forever? Read Luke 16:24. Discuss.
- What is Jesus' promise to all who will come to Him to satisfy their thirst? Read John 4:13-14.
- Have you received that Water as yet? Or are you still trying to get your thirst quenched in other places?
- What are some of those other places? And why won't they ultimately satisfy?

- Close in Prayer and Pray that that Spirit be broken over our lives and our Nation.
