Diving Deeper:

- God is less concerned about our different groups and categories, and more concerned about people hearing His voice (John 10:16). What is one way you hear His voice clearly? What's something God has told you recently?
- Because of Jesus, we have access to God's goodness. How have you seen God's goodness in your life in the last six months? How have you seen His goodness in the world in the last six months?
